HEBRON MEMORIAL BEACH ORDINANCE

We welcome you to the Hebron Memorial Beach. The beach, parking lot and adjacent town land are for the use of Hebron residents/taxpayers and their guests only. We hope you enjoy the facilities and ask that you observe the following ordinance for everyone's benefit.

- Parking is by permit in designated areas only. Stickers are required and must be visible.
- The beach, access road and parking lot open at 6:00 a.m. and close at 10:00 p.m.
- People using the beach do so at their own risk. The Town of Hebron is not liable for accidents and assumes no responsibility for lost or stolen articles.
- The following are prohibited at the Hebron Memorial Beach including the access road, parking lot and adjacent to Hebron Town property:
 - Pets
 - Use of alcoholic beverages
 - Smoking
 - Profane language
 - Illegal drugs
 - Anti-social or anti-environmental practices
 - Watercraft within the swim line or anchored to the swim line
 - Inflatable toys without parental supervision
 - Trailers, motor homes, OHRV vehicles and camping
 - Solicitation or demonstrations
- Fires are allowed in grills only.
- Only trash/garbage created at the beach shall be deposited in the dumpster/trash barrels provided at the beach. The deposit of any household trash in the provided receptacles will be considered a violation.
- No person shall feed, or otherwise attract wildlife into the area of the beach.
- Car-top carry-in non-motorized watercraft should be launched in the designated area only. No car-top carry-in watercraft shall be left overnight.
- Any unauthorized vehicle parked in the parking lot or on Hebron Memorial Beach property shall be guilty of a violation and subject to a fine of \$100.00

Violations of the foregoing ordinances may result in exclusion from the beach for one (1) year, citation and fine.

The access road to the beach is very narrow. Please use extreme caution when entering and leaving.
