## Hebron Common Landscaping & Playground Committee MEETING MINUTES

MEETING DATE: October 12, 2023

PRESENT: Fred Kohout, Chair; Mavis Brittelli; Steve Aprea; Garrey Lahey; Paul Falziano; Barbara Kohout, Secretary

Meeting called to order at 5:15pm; ended 6:19pm; Minutes for September 14, 2023 were approved;

- 1. <u>Welcomed</u> new Committee Member Steve Aprea; decided a committee member will attend Hebron Historic District Commission meetings only as needed;
- 2. <u>Watering</u>: Town Offices plantings has been discontinued for the winter & equipment (including 4 hoses and timers) to be stored in basement of Town Offices;
- 3. <u>Wintering plants</u>: A-frame snow protection cover for Threadleaf maple to be installed;

4. <u>New shade trees</u>: John Faucher confirmed TLC will plant trees; committee decided on the following list of trees for the Common:

- 1) 5 Red Maples (Acer Rubrum) 2 October Glory PNI 0268 and 3 Autumn Blaze Jeffers Red
- 2) 2 Paper Birch (Betula Papyrifera) Single Stem w/ Bright White Bark
- 3) 2 Scarlet Oak (Quercus Coccinea)
- 4) 1 Pin Oak (Quercus Palustris)

Did not consider Sugar Maples since there are several left on the Common but they don't seem to be doing well; TLC searching for a Scarlet Oak, but if not available will make a recommendation for alternatives;

- 5. <u>Reviewed quote</u> from Bartlett Tree Experts for next year. They suggest injection of Fortiphite fertilizer solution around 13 trees; soil sampling and analysis; three Phytophthora Canker treatments for 6 infected trees on large Common and also suggested organic matter and mulch around all trees;
- <u>6.</u> <u>Bocce Court:</u> Merrills gave cost estimate of \$1320 to align timbers and install Joksand surface; Committee will seek donations and present a proposal to the Select Board;
- <u>7.</u> <u>Gazebo Update</u>: Committee to complete plan for change of entrance, move stone step and touchup priming on workday 10/25; final painting after roof replacement set for Spring 24;
- 8. <u>November 2023 Newsletter</u>: items to include results of Playground Survey and items listed above;
- <u>9.</u> <u>Other business</u>: Discussed plans and budget for 2024 with anticipated proposal to the Select Board on November 16, 2023;
